A pleasant & intense wine with notes of violet, vanilla & herbs.

A great value alternative to the pricier Barolo.

Barolo DOCG 'San Carlo', Dezzani (Piedmont, Italy)

The bright red colour of Barolo is captivating, the wine itself is dry, full bodied by nature. Rich in acidity and with velvety tannins, scents of violet, rose & warm spice.

Teroldego Vigneti delle Dolomiti IGT '1339', Cantina Sociale Trento (Trentino, Italy)

Cultivated in Italy for hundreds of years, Teroldego is full, soft, easy drinking with light notes of violet, light tannins & medium alcohol.

Corvina Garda DOC, Cantina di Custoza (Veneto, Italy)

A full bodied red wine with spicy, smoky notes & smooth supple tannins. Great length.

Rosso di Montalcino DOC, Argiano (Tuscany, Italy)

Just outside the boundaries of Brunello di Montalcino lies the region of Rosso di Montalcino an excellent source of "baby Brunello". Argiano is one of the finest producers in the region and this wine offers excellent value for money. Cherry, herbs and cedar. Rich with excellent acidity.

Full bodied with spicy notes typical of this Sangiovese clone, Prugnolo Gentile & violet, blackberry & raspberry. The time in barriques give the wine aromatic notes of vanilla & coffee. Persistent on the palate with noticeable tannins married with an acidity that adds great structure

Intense garnet color. The nose shows blackberry and black cherry, hints of basil and sweet spice thanks to the time in the barrel. Soft & balanced on the palate with firm but never

Santesu Rosso IGT, Dolianova (Sardegna, Italy)

A great southern Italian red wine with warm, spicy notes of woodland berries. Warm & enveloping on the palate with good body & subtle tannins.

Aglianico Beneventano IGT, Vesevo (Campania, Italy)

A delicious and charming grape variety grown in volcanic soils. Like so many of the hundreds of grape varieties grown in Italy, Aglianico is often dwarfed by more popular wines. When made in this style it produces bright red fruit, a slick undercurrent of plum and fresh acidity.

Deep ruby red in colour with an intense and persistent nose dominated by blackberries, pepper, cherries and liquorice. Full bodied.

Deep & dark fruit with light acidity, tannin & notes of earthiness. Dry, medium body with a long finish.

A great expression of the southern Italian sunshine with deep colour intensity and dark fruit, spices & leather. Superb richness.

‘Le Demoiselle de Sociando-Mallet’ – Haut-Médoc AOC (Bordeaux, France)

Is considered as the rival to Château Montrose (a neighbouring Château), and regarded amongst Bordeaux lovers as a cherished little secret. Showing gravely blackcurrant, rich creamy forest fruit and a streak of tannin, really rather delicious!

50% MERLOT, CABERNET SAUVIGNON & n.d.

‘Sarget Gruaud-Larose’ – Saint-Julien AOC (Bordeaux, France)

Blackcurrant, plum and big red fruit flavours dominate with superb tannic balance allied to a medium-body and full plummy nose. Gruaud Larose the Wine of Kings with the approved emblem from French Royalty. BORDEAUX BLEND

Chapelle de Potensac – Médoc AOC (Bordeaux, France)

One of the ‘Super Cru Bourgeois’ wines owned by the same family as Loeville-Las Cases one of the great Saint Julien wines. All barrels are used from Leoville (after one vintage) and similar vineyard practices mean the wine produced is outstanding. A fantastic little wine.

Vacqueyras AOC, Clefs des Murailles (Southern Rhône, France)

Vacqueyras is renowned for producing big, expressive, generous wines, similar in style to Châteauneuf-du-Pape. With a blend of Grenache, Syrah and Mourvedre, it has an intense deep purple colour and is rich with aromas of red and black fruit & liquorice. Bold, fruity and silky on the palate, delightful with red meat or strong cheese.

70% GRENACHE, 20% SYRAH, 10% MOURVEDRE

Gigondas AOC, Château de Saint Cosme (Southern Rhône, France)

There’s something absolutely enchanting about good Gigondas, when Rhone wines are specified from a single village the character of the fruit becomes far more pronounced. With a majority of Grenache and a little Mourvedre and Cinsault. Saint Cosme uses no filtration, sustainable farming methods and the upmost care to produce world class wine. Mint, pepper, violet, ginger and blackcurrant. A deliciously structured wine.

50% GRENACHE, 30% MOURVEDRE, SHIRAZ, CINSULT n.d.

Syrah, Domaine Gayda – Pays d’Oc IGP (Languedoc, France)

The Cepage range of wines from Domaine Gayda focuses on mimicking classic French styles from around the country. This Syrah is equal in power to the concentration of a baby Châteauneuf Du Pape. Blackcurrant, spice and liquorice with little leathery tannins.

100% SYRAH

Grenache, Domaine Gayda – Pays d’Oc IGP (Languedoc, France)

Displaying an explosive red fruit profile with moderate grippy tannins, surprising acidity and an elegance and impressive longevity on the finish. This is a serious Grenache with a purity of fruit and concentration. It shows real richness and depth whilst keeping the lively fruit expression synonymous of its varietal. 100% GRENACHE

'Gran Opalo', Mauricio Lorca (Uco Valley, Argentina)

One of the most characteristic, expressive, complex red wines in Argentina. With only 1,300 bottles produced, this wine is the jewel of Mauricio's production. Using no oak and grown at 3,500 feet altitude the wine shows an explosion of fruit on the nose, soft tannin, outstanding structure and purity. An amazing bottle of wine.

30% MALBEC, 30% CABERNET SAUVIGNON, 30% SYRAH, 10% PETIT VERDOT

Malbec 'Fantasia', Mauricio Lorca (Uco Valley, Argentina)

Mauricio's elevated vineyards produce incredibly pure fruit in Uco Valley. His approach to wine making tends to favour minimal oak and maximum fruit character. The Fantasia Malbec utilizes only 40% barrel age allowing the bright silky Malbec fruit to shine through.

Trapiche, Pure Malbec (Uco Valley, Argentina)

An honest Malbec, blending soft, creamy fruit with polished oak and butter-soft tannins. The classic palate is vividly expressive and lifted, with lovely floral and fruit characters winding throughout

Pinot Noir 'Gran Reserva', Viña Chocalán (Maipo Valley, Chile)

Cabernet Sauvignon 'Max Reserva', Errazuriz (Aconcagua Valley, Chile)

Characterized by elegant fruit, black and red cherry aromas are backed by notes of tobacco, cedar and cinnamon. A full-bodied wine that enters broadly and fills the mouth. Aged for 15 months in 66% French and 34% American oak barrels, the young, spicy tannins give structure and depth to the rich fruit. 100% CABERNET SAUVIGNON

'Red', Sequillo (WO Swartland, South Africa)

One of South Africa's most iconic wine dynasties, the Saide family produces this outstanding red wine. SYRAH, MOURVEDRE, GRENACHE, CARIGNAN, CINSULT n.d.

Laszlo, Fleur du Cap (WO Coastal Region, South Africa)

Malolactic in barrel and cleared by racking. From two Stellenbosch vineyards, 18 months in new French oak. Black cherry and cassis on the nose, the oak adding creaminess rather than toast and cherry character. The palate has a big biting, plum skin tang as well as the sweet fruit, with a nicely dry finish and quite refined tannin quality.

35% MERLOT, 32% CABERNET SAUVIGNON, 22% PETIT VERDOT, 11% MALBEC

Grenache 'Dean Hewitson Tribute', Dean Hewitson (McLaren Vale, Australia)

A lovely easy drinking wine. Produced in the McLaren Vale, one of the coolest regions in Australia, has got full ripe fruit, fairly intense in the nose. The mouth is powerful and rich. Some sweetness appears in the mid-palate. A nice Grenache and very good value for moneywine.

Mourvèdre 'Baby Bush', Dean Hewitson (Barossa, Australia)

Sourced from the cuttings of the oldest Mourvedre vines in the world (over 150 years old!). Whilst you may not know the grape, it's almost impossible to forget the violet, blackcurrant, spice and silky palate of this absolute show stopper.

100% MOURVEDRE

Man O' War Ironclad (Waipara Valley, New Zealand)

A blend of Bordeaux grape varieties from no less than 45 different plots, which are all handled separately in the winery to maximize their individual potential before being blended, Ironclad has huge complexity of blue and black fruits, crushed stone, chalk and wild thyme. The palate is very concentrated with a supple texture and a streak of minerality on the finish.

Battalion-s of tannin accompany ripe fruit flavors in this bold, full bodied wine made from Petite Syrah and Petit Verdot. A supportive wrap of astringency from layers of fine tannin bolsters the rich blackberry and blueberry flavors, while flashy, spicy, smoky, new-oak accents infuse everything from the aroma to the finish.

Incognito Red Michael David Winery (California, United States)

This wine is made up of a field blend of made of predominantly Rhone varietals.

Intense aromas of leather, earth, and hickory smoke give way to black fruit as the wine breathes. Dark plum, black currant and a hint of spice paired with polished tannins create a full-bodied and flavorful Petit Verdot

Adelsheim Pinot Noir Michael David Winery (Willamette Valley, Oregon)

With its broad array of origins and clones, this wine displays red aromas (candied cherry, pomegranate and raspberry) on the nose and the palate. In addition, one finds a light touch of brown spices (nutmeg, cinnamon, all-spice. It is elegantly textured with seamlessly integrated, silky, polished tannins.

Murphy-Goode Merlot (California, United States)

The easy-going persona of the Murphy Goode Winery is exemplified in this smooth medium-bodied California wine. The Murphy-Good Merlot has rich aromas and flavors of black cherry, blueberry, and blackberry.

Often the exposure of Italian white wine is limited to Pinot Grigio and antiquated Frascati! Saladini Pilastrini shows just how excellent white wine from Italy can be. Using the grapes varieties Pecorino & Passerina Pilastrini craft a fresh, mineral wine with taught acidity and excellent structure, really quite delicious.

Trebbiano d'Abruzzo DOC, Nicodemi (Abruzzo, Italy)

Regarded by a number of Italian wine critics including Robert Parker as the finest estate in Abruzzo, this Trebbiano is a fine example of the grape character when it's manipulated with care. Bright fresh lemon fruit with a rich rounded palate and a clean acidity, the perfect accompaniment to shellfish. 100% TREBBIANO

Passerina DOP, Cantina Tollo (Abruzzo, Italy)

Fruity fragrance with hints of peach, apricot & grapefruit. Floral notes with a distinctive mineral character. Full bodied & well balanced with great length.

100% PASSERINA

Passerina DOC 'Tollum', Feudo Antico (Abruzzo, Italy)

Pale yellow color that is revealed to the eye. The nose gives a fruity and floral bouquet, which is attractively decorated with subtle mineral notes. The palate is fresh and smooth, matching the nose and persistent.

Beneventano Falanghina IGT, Vesevo (Campania, Italy)

Campania's grape varieties have ancient origins as they were brought to the region by the Greeks some 2,500 years ago. We just love this Falanghina: mouth-filling yet fresh and vivid. Greco di Tufo DOCG, Vesevo (Campania, Italy)

One of Italy's most esoteric grape varieties and yet further proof of amazing diversity to be found in the country's wine production. 'Tufo' refers to the chunks of chalk that are found where this grape variety thrives. Orange blossom flavours, high minerality, rounded texture and good acidity.

Pouilly-Fuissé AOC, Eric Forest (Burgundy, France)

Eric is the son of one of the most famous Pouilly-Fuissé producers in the Macon, without doubt his 'Sur La Roche cuvee rivals his father's wines. An outstanding wine packed with class and elegance, the use of oak is judicious yet still provides a rich, honeyed palate.

Menetou Salon AOC 'Les Bornés', Domaine Henry Pellé (Loire, France)

Menetou Salon is one of the best kept secrets in the Loire, the wines produced here are of amazing quality. Henry Pellé is one of the leading producers of the region, this single vineyard Les Bournes cuvee has grassy freshness, a green silky palate and excellent freshness.

Sancerre AOC 'Le Coix Au Garde', Domaine Henry Pellé (Loire, France)

Henry Pellé's outstanding Sancerre shows Sauvignon Blanc's tendency to produce delicious, grassy wines that are soft in texture but have fine acidity.

A great example proving that Argentina is not only all about the Malbec. With the amazing elevation of 3,500 feet the Viognier can ripen properly but also take on a finer and more elegant quality than is usually found. With 40% oak ageing the palate is rounded, rich, peachy and extremely elegant. 100% VIOGNIER

Sauvignon Blanc 'Selección', Viña Chocalán (DO Maipo Valley, Chile)

A vibrant and powerful easy drinking white, light and herbal on the nose and packed with exotic and green fruits flavours! Excellent with raw fish and shellfish preparations!

Sauvignon Blanc, Errazuriz (DO Casablanca Valley, Chile)

From the Casablanca Valley, which is heavily moderated by its close proximity to the Pacific Ocean and benefiting from cool air and morning fogs. Fleshy ripe rosé from Portugal, with clean acidity but a firm plum and strawberry fruit upfront.

Another food and summer friendly rosé.

100% ALFROCHEIRO

Montepulciano Terre degli osci IGT 'Rosavite', Terresacre (Molise, Italy)

Excellent as an aperitif. Good with seafood or appetizers, meats and cheese. Easy to combine with first and second courses of meat or fish.

100% MONTEPULCIANO

'D2' Coteaux d'Aix en Provence AOC, Famille Double (Provence, France)

Fruity and fresh wine with a nice frame of red fruits, supported by vivacity and minerality.

Deliciously indulgent, invigorating and very refreshing with aromas of wild, summer flowers and a hint of peach. Perfect for our style of Mediterranean food.

GRENACHE, CARIGNAN, CAB SAUV n.d.

'Rose' Torres Mas Rabell (Catalunya, Spain)

Bright with vivid crimson highlights. The intense aroma offers floral lilac and redcurrant notes. On the palate, it is seductive, round and sensual (notes of coconut).

CARINENA, SYRAH, TEMPRANILLO n.d.

Dessert Wines

Torres, Moscatel Oro (Spain)

Both Moscatel de Alejandria and Moscatel de Grano Menudo, better known as Muscat de Frontignan, are raisins before pressing. Grape brandy is added to arrest the fermentation.

Passito Verdicchio dei Castelli di Jesi DOC, 'Tordiruta', Moncaro (Marche, Italy)

An award winning sweet, walnutty, wine with an intense candied, citrus fruit & honey bouquet and hints of spices & exotic fruits. Excellent acidity.

Top Cuvées

Brunello di Montalcino DOCG 'Tenuta Greppone Mazzi', Ruffino (Tuscany, Italy)

From Ruffino, this Brunello is ripe yet earthy, with a touch of forest and moss to the nose. It may be softer and riper than many, but it's definitely well balanced. Meanwhile, fine black cherry and plum fruit steals the palate, which also dishes hints of chocolate and fennel.

100% SANGIOVESE

'Tignanello' Toscana IGT, Marchesi Antinori (Tuscany, Italy)

This was the first Sangiovese to be aged in barriques, the first red wine to be blended with non-traditional varieties and one of the first Chianti reds not to use white grapes. Tignanello is a milestone! The wine is ripe on the nose with notes of dark fruit and with much underlying freshness on the aromatic finish; plum fruit dominates the aromatic aromas along with cherries, and the essence evolve with vigor and balance towards sensations of mint and liquorice.

SANGIOVESE, CABERNET SAUVIGNON & CABERNET FRANC n.d.

'Pietradonice' Toscana IGT, Casanova di Neri (Tuscany, Italy)

Sumptuous & super intense. Dark black cherries, blackberry jam and herbs are expressed in this intense, full bodied Cabernet.

100% CABERNET SAUVIGNON

'Luce della Vite' Toscana IGT, Tenuta della Luce (Tuscany, Italy)

It took the vision & courage of two expert and passionate wine makers such as Lamberto Frescobaldi e Tim Mondavi to realize that the roundness and the softness of Merlot added to the solid structure and elegance of Sangiovese would make a beautiful wine in the stronghold of Brunello di Montalcino.

SANGIOVESE & MERLOT n.d.

'Solaia' Toscana IGT, Marchesi Antinori (Tuscany, Italy)

Because of this varietal composition, the soil and the winemaker's hand, Solaia is considerably more elegant than many of the other Super-Tuscans: not brash with fruit, not as tannic, not as oaky, and not as alcoholic. It is sexily lean, has a sophisticated refinement, along with beautifully subtle aromas and flavors.

75% CABERNET SAUVIGNON, 20% SANGIOVESE AND 5% CABERNET FRANC

'Argentiera' Bolgheri DOC Superiore, Tenuta Argentiera (Tuscany, Italy)

Intense and luminous shades of a dark ruby red color. Very complex on the nose with fresh hints of cherries, plum and cassis going over to berries from the woods. Along there are intense and spicy balsamic notes, finishing with some well integrated roasted hints. On the palate gives deep and velvety sensations. The wine shows harmonic notes and is intriguing, because of the sapid and mineral aftertaste; well balanced between fineness, tannic structure and the lingering finish.

Top Cuvées

Château Rauzan-Ségla, Grand Cru Classé – Margaux AOC (Bordeaux, France)

The 2008 Rauzan-Ségla (62% Cabernet Sauvignon and 38% Merlot) was made from 45% of the production. It is a beautiful wine in this vintage, it has complex notes of sweet red and black fruits, un smoked cigar tobacco, spice box and a hint of very subtle wood. The complex perfume is followed by a dark ruby/plum-colored wine with beautifully sweet tannins, a silky, medium to full-bodied mouth feel, and a long finish..

Château Clerc-Milon, Grand Cru Classé – Pauillac AOC (Bordeaux, France)

Showing true Medoc and specifically Pauillac character with black olive, firm tannins and blackcurrant. Authentic and genuine Bordeaux from the second estate of Mouton Rothschild. CABERNET SAUVIGNON, MERLOT, CABERNET FRANC, PETIT VERDOT AND CARMENERE n. d.

Château Montrose – Saint-Estèphe AOC (Bordeaux, France)

Very dark, crimson-black hue with a thin crimson rim. The nose, is just delightful, the very dark fruit taking on perfumed and very floral character with a little pencil lead too, laced with little notes of soot suggesting an undercurrent of tannin. A great purity here despite the fine concentration so evident. The palate is beautifully harmonious with polished and sweet layers.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON, MERLOT, CABERNET FRANC, PETIT VERDOT AND CARMENERE n. d.

Château Gruaud Larose, Grand Cru Classé St Julien AOC (Bordeaux, France)

A dark purple color is followed by intense aromas of cherry liqueur, cassis, smoke, dried herbs, and leather. Heady, ripe, medium to full-bodied, and authoritatively flavored, this effort has good weight and overall balance and harmony.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON, MERLOT, PETIT VERDOT, MALBEC n.d.

Château Léoville Barton, Cru Classé – St-Julien AOC (Bordeaux, France)

For those who love St Julien the wines of Anthony Barton hold a special place in their hearts.

Always stunningly dependable and fairly priced, Leoville is classic Saint Julien. Still fresh but retaining its extracted and raisin, sooty and very masculine richness. If you've never drank Leoville and love Bordeaux this is well, well worth a try. Delicious.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON 60-70% AND MERLOT 20-30% with PETIT VERDOT AND CABERNET FRANC.

Château Figeac, Premier Grand Cru Classé –AOC (Bordeaux, France)

Renowned for their inclusion of a little extra Cabernet Sauvignon compared to other St. Emilion Estates, Figeac makes beautiful wines. The 2008 is fine, elegant, mineral and reserved but still retains a supple richness, a real class act!

35% CABERNET SAUVIGNON, 35% CABERNET FRANC AND 30% MERLOT

Vieux Château Certan, Grand Vin – Pomerol AOC (Bordeaux, France)

A stone throw from Le Pin (one of the most expensive wines in the world) it is also owned by the same person. Winemaking here is impeccable and the wines often touch on the greatest that is produced across the road at Le Pin. A contender, if not the winner, of the vintage. Rounded, sweet, dense, fine and ethereal red wine. You can drink a bottle of this wine, and then another... ..

CABERNET FRANC, MERLOT n.d.

Top Cuvées

Château Duhart Milon, Grand Cru Classé – Pauillac AOC (Bordeaux, France)

Meteoric rises in terms of quality have resulted in Duhart being tasted and compared to its brother and sister Estate Lafite Rothschild and Carruades. The opportunity to drink 2008 should not be missed. Perfumed, fine, mineral, elegant fruit. A real superstar for those that wish to drink a Lafite at half the price (for the moment...)

CABERNET SAUVIGNON, MERLOT, CABERNET FRANC, PETIT VERDOT AND CARMENERE n. d.

Château Angelus Premier Grand Cru Classé – Saint-Emilion Grand Cru AOC (Bordeaux, France)

Angelus is a big, big wine and with numerous critics awarding nearly perfect scores for this wine, it is destined for fame. Dark brooding fruit with precise execution; ripe and rounded, seriously amazing wine! CABERNET SAUVIGNON, CABERNET FRANC & MERLOT n.d.

Château Mouton Rothschild, Premier Cru Classé– Pauillac AOC (Bordeaux, France)

The saturated ruby/purple color is followed by sumptuous aromas of cedar wood, creme de cassis, wood smoke, coffee and dried herbs. The wine is forward, full bodied, lush and succulent. Supple tannins and elegant complexity with a long finish. It's a complex, classic Mouton.

2001 vintage,

'Opus One', Mondavi/Rothschild (Napa Valley, California)

Saturated black-purple, aromas of fresh cut roses, liquorice, dark chocolate, blackberry pie, smoked bacon and saffras. Simultaneously silky and dense on the palate, this refined wine offers flavours of cassis, espresso and black cherry with a persistently smooth yet expansive finish.

79% CABERNET SAUVIGNON, 7% CABERNET FRANC, 6% PETIT VERDOT, 6% MALBEC, 2% MERLOT

'Dominus', Dominus Estate (Napa Valley, California)

This wine harmoniously integrates tremendous power, purity of fruit and lingering finesse. It clearly possesses an exceptional potential for ageing!

93% CABERNET SAUVIGNON, 2% CABERNET FRANC, 5% PETIT VERDOT

Top Cuvee Whites

Vermentino Isola dei Nuraghi IGT 'Santiagaini', Capichera (Sardinia, Italy)

The word *Santiagaini* in the local dialect means *October*, which is the harvesting time of this precious indigenous grape variety. Strong straw yellow colour and green hue. At the nose flavours of white flowers, honey, orange blossom, wild aromatic herbs and lavender. Great and full texture, yet fresh and mineral with a long finish.

100% VERMENTINO DI SARDEGNA

Chardonnay 'Cutting Wharf Vineyard', Cakebread (Napa Valley, California, USA)

Fresh and fragrant ripe apple, pear, melon and mineral aromas with lightly creamy, richly textured and deeply concentrated golden apple, citrus and ripe melon flavors. Capped off by a long, elegant finish.

100% CHARDONNAY

Champagne & Sparkling

Franciacorta Brut DOCG, 2009, Monzio Compagnoni (Lombardia, Italy)

Straw yellow, fine & persistent perlage. Dominating aromas come from white fruit such as apple & pear as well as nutty flavours. Dry, complex, fruity balanced with sweetness. Good acidity.

80% CHARDONNAY, 20% PINOT NOIR

Moët & Chandon Brut Impérial, NV (Épernay, France)

Pale yellow with a soft bouquet of citrus and Pinot. Fresh and dry on the palate.

PINOT NOIR, PINOT MEUNIER, CHARDONNAY n.d

Veuve Clicquot 'Yellow Label' Brut, NV (Reims, France)

A perennial favourite of mine, the nose is rife with mineral, lemon drop, crisp apple and yeast. The mousse is creamy, with lemon citrus, pear and mandarin orange notes and bright acids.

PINOT NOIR, PINOT MEUNIER, CHARDONNAY n.d

Dom Pérignon Brut, 2004

Dom Pérignon is at first intensely floral, with perfumed jasmine that dominates the bouquet. Tropical with apricots, passion fruit and peaches emerging from this flashy, opulent full meal wine!

PINOT NOIR, CHARDONNAY n.d.

Krug Grande Cuvée Brut, NV

Beautifully deep golden amber in appearance, it just melts effortlessly in the mouth but packs a big vanilla, toast, brioche and a slight tropical hint.
